Contributions by different corporations are considered as being made by one contributor if the corporation was owned by the same stockholders or one corporation wholly owns the other. Further, under current law, business entities such as partnerships are not required to attribute contributions to other wholly owned business entities, as are corporations. The current four-year cycle is January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2006.
