- Tax Info
- Search for eBooks and magazine, newspaper, and encyclopedia articles.

Not comfortable reading on the computer? Then use the alternative technology: Ask-a-Librarian. This is a 24/7 service you can access via email or live chat. If you would like to use Ask-a-Librarian by phone, call (240) 777-0001 during regular library hours.

You can renew your books online, place holds for videos, make online payments, volunteer, find a job, reserve a meeting room and make MCPL's Virtual Library your homepage!

Finally, you can watch the construction of the new Rockville Library, scheduled to open in summer 2006. Once completed, this branch will house the business resource center. Legislative Update



With the end of this year's General Assembly session in Annapolis and the beginning of the County Council's annual budget deliberations in Rockville, several significant legislative achievements have been realized on issues important to the business community.

Locally, in mid-April the Council passed legislation to establish a Small Business Reserve Program for county contacts. This measure was one of the top priorities of the Greater Bethesda-Chevy Chase Chamber of Commerce. It had been sought after by small businesses for decades. Under this program, all county departments must purchase 10 percent of goods and services from Montgomery County small businesses. This is modeled after a similar initiative adopted by the State of Maryland.

The new program requires county departments to post on the Internet all planned purchases between \$5,000 and \$25,000 for five days before the purchase is made or the contract is entered into. Previously, there was no requirement that the public be notified of purchases under \$25,000. In 2004, \$1.2 million of "informal" purchases were made this way, not subject to competitive bidding or public notification. This Internet provision, like the new Small Business Reserve Program, will generate significant new procurement opportunities for local small businesses, which constitute the county's largest source of private sector jobs.

At the state level, agreement was reached on a funding plan for the Intercounty Connector road project, another priority of our Chamber. This was one of the last hurdles to overcome before the ICC can proceed to construction later next year.

Other successful business priorities in Annapolis were re-enactment of Maryland's Research and Development tax credit, which had expired in 2004, and the passage of a new Biotechnology Investment Incentive tax credit.

On the downside, the General Assembly enacted legislation to mandate that employers with 10,000 or more employees offer health insurance to their employees, or else pay a payroll tax to the State if they do not spend at least 8 percent of their payroll on medical benefits. This sets a precedent for the State to tell businesses they have to offer health care and how much they must provide. You can be certain that it will only be a matter of time before attempts are made to extend this requirement to other businesses throughout the State.
